

# ELECTION

Volunteering to serve on your community's Board of Directors is a vital function for any association. Commencing in January 2011 four positions will be open, each consisting of two-year terms. You will be required to attend monthly meetings on the second Saturday of each month, and generally devote the time necessary in working on various projects.

In compliance with our By-laws, the Board is announcing here that we have four seats up for election. All Directors must have paid all dues, assessments, and fines owed to the Association and must be members in good standing as defined in III.6. Only one member of a household may serve on the Board of Directors at any given time. Our By-laws also requires that we reproduce Article VI.3.b.

*“Between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> day of June each year, commencing with 1980, any member, including incumbents, who is in good standing as defined herein may file with the Election Committee a statement of the member's candidacy for election as a Director of the Association for the term beginning the next calendar year following the August meeting of the Association held after the filing of such statement. A brief resume, supplied by the candidate, is to be included in the notice of the August meeting. An Election Committee appointed by the President shall consist of no fewer than 3 or more than 5 members in good standing. Neither current Directors nor their relatives, neither candidates for office or their relatives, nor any employee of the Association shall serve on the Election Committee. Statements of candidacy and resumes are to be **mailed** to the Election Committee at HC1 Box 152, Hawley, Pa. 18428 and **must be postmarked by June 15** at the latest. The Election Committee will open applications on June 25 or the next weekday.”*

The Election/Nomination Committee will oversee the entire process for accuracy and integrity. Candidates must comply with our By-laws and **MAIL** their candidacy material to HC1 Box 152, Hawley Pa. 18428 postmarked no later than June 15. There will be no exceptions.
