

It has come to our attention that one of our most valued resources is under attack. Our lake is being abused and stripped of its fish by outsiders. Non members have been putting gas driven motors on our lake which pollutes the water. Others have been poaching fish of all sizes and then bragging about it to other outsiders...It is up to us to protect our assets. If you observe any illegal activities on the lake call **570-226-3424 and report it. Pertinent sections of the rules and regulations are sited below for you information. This is your lake and assets please help protect them.**

ARTICLE I – MEMBERSHIP

1. Every property owner is required to join the Paupackan Lake Association.
2. All privileges such as fishing, swimming, etc., which require the use of the lake or the land surrounding it, except the individual's lot, are contingent upon membership in good standing in the Paupackan Lake Association.

ARTICLE II – BOATS

1. No fuel-powered boats are permitted on Paupackan Lake, except for maintenance of the lake.

ARTICLE III – FISHING

1. Each member is permitted two (2) fishing guests. One person must display the Association Button, preferably on a hat, but if no hat is worn, it must be prominently displayed on the shirt or coat.
2. State regulations mandate the size and creel limit for all species. The Association reserves the right to impose stricter size and creel limits.
3. The host is always responsible for guest/s. The host should be certain the guest/s are made aware of the Association rules.
4. Fishing is not permitted in the beach/swimming area. Fishing is permitted beyond the spillway toward East Shore Drive.
5. State of Pennsylvania fishing licenses are required by State law.
6. Guest/s are not permitted to fish without the property owner present from 12 Midnight to 4 A.M.
